The following items are the responsibility of the homeowner to recycle or dispose of on their own:

- a. Lumber, Demolition & Construction debris
- b. Tires, Air conditioners & Microwaves
- c. Computers, electronics, televisions & fluorescent light bulbs
- d. Anything with an engine such as lawn mowers, chain saws etc.
- e. Appliances, dehumidifiers, stoves
- f. Wet paint or liquid
- g. Hazardous Waste
- h. Iron/metal scrap

BRIEF DESCRIPTION OF ITEMS TO BE PICKED UP:

ITEM PREPARATION

- Any fabric item must be wrapped in plastic.
- Carpeting and padding must be neatly rolled or folded and placed by the curb.
- Glass products and items with sharp edges must be placed in puncture-resistant containers (for example, coffee cans, 2-liter bottles, heavy boxes) before putting them in the plastic refuse bag.

IMPORTANT INFORMATION

- Place your bulk items in the same area as your garbage can.
- All items must be placed in the street against the curb.
- Do not block sidewalks, driveways, fire hydrants, storm drains, garbage cans, etc.
- Items must be placed on the street in front of your own residence.
- **No items will be collected in the alley.**
